- Testimony in criminal and civil cases related to findings and interpretations of examined evidence and discovery.
- Collect and preserve physical evidence, accurately write reports, communicate effectively and participate in customer service, peer review, case presentations and training.

Qualifications and requirements: Bachelors degree in criminalistics, forensic science or natural science. At least 5 years of experience working in a forensic crime laboratory setting and completion of a recognized training program (at least 2 years) in firearms and toolmark examinations (internal, external, intermediate and wound ballistics).
